

**Position:** Assistant Professor of Psychology

**Job Summary:** Candidates should be student-centered and highly motivated with the ability and willingness to teach both undergraduate and graduate level courses in research methods, experimental psychology, statistics, history and systems, and abnormal psychology. The normal teaching load per academic year is 12-credits in each fall and spring semester. This appointment also includes research, practical supervision with students, student advising, and research mentoring for both undergraduate and graduate students.

**Qualifications:**

- Ph.D. in Experimental, Clinical or Counseling Psychology from an accredited institution and an American Psychological Association (APA) accredited program at the time of application is required;
- Preference will be given to applicants who have experience and proficiency in conducting research, as well as prior experience in teaching upper-division undergraduate courses;
- Candidates invited to interview will be asked to provide three letters of reference.
