- _ Special Event Ambassadors** Attend special events, including Terrier Tuesday (Sept.) and Open House (Fall and Spring). Greet students, give tours, and share your personal experience with prospective students and their families. Semester commitment: 2-3 days per semester.
- _ Digital Ambassadors** Write and/or take photos for the St. Francis College Admissions Blog on Tumblr: www.sfc.nyc. Blog about your experience at St. Francis College. Digital Ambassadors may also participate in Weekly Online Chat sessions with Admissions Counselors and prospective students. Semester commitment: 1 day per month.
- _ Social Media Ambassadors** Actively participate in creating and posting content to the Office of Admissions social media accounts. Weekly commitment: 1 day per week.
- _ International Ambassadors** Assist with international recruitment, including writing for the St. Francis College Admissions Blog, writing letters and emails to prospective students in their native language, welcoming international students to campus, and chatting online during weekly chat sessions with Admissions Counselor and prospective students. Weekly commitment: 1 day per week.
- _ Campus Tour Ambassadors** During a designated time slot, lead campus tours for prospective students and their families and share your personal experience with prospective students. Weekly commitment: 1 day per week.
- _ Outreach Ambassadors** With an Admissions Counselor, visit your high school and/or College Fairs and additional off campus events to share your personal experience with prospective students. Semester commitment: 1 day per semester.
- _ Welcome Ambassadors** During a designated time slot, provide in-office assistance to Admissions staff, including greeting visitors, answering telephones, and leading campus tours for prospective students and their families, and share your personal experience with prospective students. Weekly commitment: 1 day per week.
