

**Alfred University Partnership with St. Francis College BA/MA & MA programs in  
Psychology**

**Certificate of Advanced Study in Mental Health Counseling**

- Students who graduate from either our BA/MA program or MA programs will be automatically accepted (with approval from the SFC Psychology Department) into Alfred University's Certificate of Advanced Study in Mental Health Counseling
- Completion of this certificate will allow students to be eligible for licensure as a Mental Health Counselor
- The certificate requires an additional 24 credits of coursework completed through Alfred University
  - The Alfred University coursework can be completed at satellite campuses around New York City (including St. Francis College)
  - There is a requirement that students spend 4-6 days at the Alfred campus in Alfred, NY during the summer – Alfred University will assist with transportation and housing during this week
  - Courses are offered on Saturdays and are designed for working students who already hold an MA in Psychology
- Students must first graduate from SFC with their Master's degree from either the BA/MA or MA programs, then they may apply to the certificate program at Alfred University
- This is a separate program from St. Francis College, students pay tuition/fees to Alfred University once they are enrolled in the certificate program
