Job Summary: St. Francis College seeks an experienced nurse educator to serve as an Associate Professor or Professor of Nursing and Nursing Department Chairperson. Primary responsibilities include overseeing the College's Nursing programs; supervising, mentoring, and evaluating department faculty and staff; teaching courses and assigning teaching responsibilities; coordinating clinical placements and assignments; coordinating accreditation activities; directing course and program assessment; developing and overseeing budgets; and performing other essential departmental functions.

Qualifications:

- Earned doctorate in nursing or a related field.
- Current, unencumbered New York State RN license.
- A minimum of five years of experience in nursing education, at least three of which should include leadership experience in associate, baccalaureate or masters-level nursing education; program accreditation experience is preferred.
- Demonstrated ability in teaching, curriculum development, and assessment is required.
- Evidence of effective interpersonal communication skills and ability to work with a diverse college community.
